

SOLID WASTE AND BULK MATERIAL DISPOSAL

LEAVES

The City of Plymouth will collect leaves raked on the boulevard each fall as always.

OTHER COMPOSTABLES

(Grass Clippings, Yard and Garden Waste)

No curbside pickup is provided. The City will provide a drop off site at the City Garage on Valley Road. Drop off site is available during normal working hours. From mid-April to mid-November the garage will be open on Saturdays. Hours are posted. It is recommended that you do not collect your grass clippings, but allow them to decompose on the lawn.

BRUSH

No curbside pickup is provided. The City will provide a drop off site at the City Garage on Valley Road. Drop off site is available during normal working hours. From mid-April to Mid-November the garage will be open on Saturdays. Hours are posted. Special collection can be arranged at owners expense. Call the City Hall, 893-1271

BULK MATERIALS

Curbside pickup will be made each week for furniture items. A limit of two cubic yards per month per household will be enforced.

Construction, remodeling and demolition debris (roofing, siding, plaster, drywall, scrap lumber) will not be picked up by the city's hauler.

White goods with Freon (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers) will not be picked up by the city's hauler. The owner must contract a private hauler for these items.

White goods, non-Freon (washers, dryers and stoves) can be disposed of at the City Garage on Valley Road.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION/DISPOSAL (Household waste)

Services have been contracted of the City of Plymouth. Curbside pickup will be provided once each week. Household waste must be placed in a **CLEAR BAG**. Household garbage in the wrong type of bag or containing items that must be recycled shall not be collected and be red tagged. Bags shall be of sufficient strength to be handled by lifting from the top of the bag.

Recyclable items are prohibited from the regular garbage bags and must be handled in compliance with the reverse side of this page.

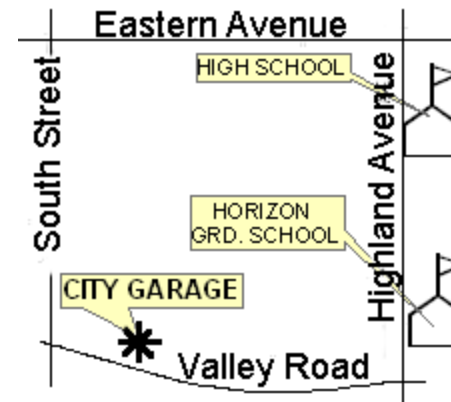
Ordinances are in place to enforce all provision of the Solid Waste Program in the City of Plymouth.

OTHER RECYCLABLE ITEMS

Materials	What do I Recycle?	Instructions	What Can't be Recycled
 Newspapers	Newspapers, junk mail, office paper, magazines	Either place in cardboard box or paper bag, or tie with string into bundles no larger than 10" in height.	
 Corrugated Cardboard	All cardboard except Pizza boxes	Flatten boxes . Tie in bundles or place in another box or paper bag.	Pizza boxes.
 Waste Oil	Motor oil.	Transport in reusable container to approved waste oil disposal site. One is available at City Garage, Valley Road.	Paints, antifreeze and other non-petroleum based liquids.

- Place trash and recycling at the curb no earlier than 6 pm the day before and no later than 6 am the day of pickup.
- Glass, plastic and metal containers should go in a blue recycling bag that can be purchased at retail outlets in Plymouth.
- Newspapers, corrugated cardboard, and other paper recyclables will be **TIED in BUNDLES or PLACED in CORRUGATED CARDBOARD BOX or in a PAPER BAG, such as a grocery store bag**, and placed curbside, adjacent to the blue recycling bag.
- You don't have to put out a recycling bag each week. Put out only full bags.
