

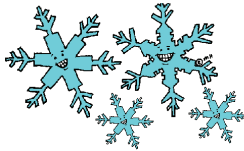
Parking

There is no parking on city streets and city municipal parking lots from 2:00 am to 6:00 am, beginning December 1 through March 15.



Snow Removal

Your sidewalk must be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours of the end of a snowfall. Failure to do so will result in the City clearing the sidewalk and charging the property owner for service. Do not push or blow snow into street.



Park Reservations

Reservation for use of park facilities are to be made in person at City Hall beginning the first Monday in February. Reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis.

Fire Pits



Per ordinance 5-2-9, permits are required for all fire pits. The cost is \$5 per year. Permit applications may be picked up at City Hall.

House Numbers

Home owners, occupants or landlords are required to affix house numbers to front of homes. House numbers shall not be less than 4 inches in size.

Trees

Trees must be planted at least 6 feet from the front property line.



Yard Waste



Tree branches and all yard waste may be dropped off at the City Garage (see map).

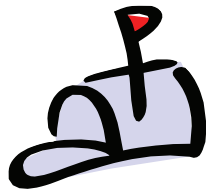
Grass Clippings - Dispose grass clippings at the City Garage (see map). Do not place grass clippings in gutter.

Leaves - In the Fall, you may rake leaves into the street gutter. They will be collected by the City.



Mailboxes

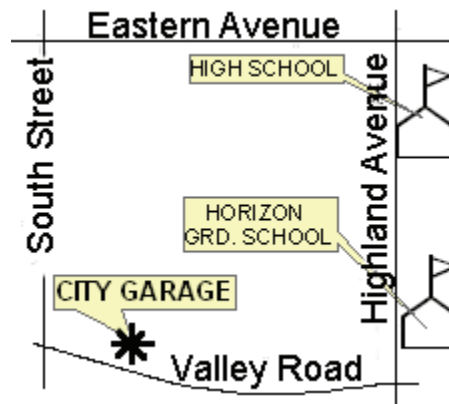
Rural mailboxes must be set back, so **front** of box is even with **back** of curb, at least 6" behind curb.



Hazardous Waste

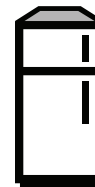
Hazardous waste may be dropped off at the Plymouth City Garage located at **1004 Valley Road**. This Sheboygan County collection site is open from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon on the first Saturday of Feb., April, June, Aug., Oct. and Dec. or until funding is depleted.

Oil -Used oil can be dropped off at the City Garage. See map above.

Freon - You must pay an outside vendor to dispose of any item containing freon (air conditioners refrigerators, freezers, and dehumidifiers). When purchasing a new appliance containing freon, we recommend you ask your appliance dealer to remove your old appliance or you may contact Larry's Hauling 866-652-7797 for disposal.



Garbage Collection

Garbage is collected four days per week Tuesday thru Friday. Details are listed on our web site <http://www.plymouthgov.com/DPW/recycle.htm>



Garbage must be placed on the curb in clear plastic bags. Large bulky items should weigh no more than 60 pounds. Recycling waste must be placed in blue bags.

Yard Signs
