

**CITY OF PLYMOUTH
CHAPTER NO. 2 ORDINANCES OF 2010**

An Ordinance Amending Section 2-3-4(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth Establishing the Term of the City Attorney

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2-3-4(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth is hereby created to read as follows:

(a) **Appointment.** The office of City Attorney is an appointed position. The Common Council shall appoint the City Attorney, who shall have a two (2) year term commencing on May 1st of each odd-numbered year.

SECTION 2: A City Attorney shall be appointed by the Common Council to serve from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011, a one year term, until commencement of the regular two year term commencing on May 1, 2011.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
