

**CITY OF PLYMOUTH
CHAPTER NO. 4 ORDINANCES OF 2010**

An Ordinance Amending Section 13-1-174 (c) of the
Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth with Regard to Board
of Appeals Fees.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, and after a public hearing having been held thereon, Section 13-1-174 (c) of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth is hereby amended to read as follows:

(c) **Variance Application.** All applications for special exceptions and variances and appeals shall be filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer along with a One Hundred-Fifty Dollar (\$150.00) filing fee. The filing fee shall be used to reimburse the City for publication and administration costs incurred in relation to the application or appeal and hearings thereon. The City Clerk-Treasurer, upon receipt of an application or appeal and the fee provided herein, shall immediately refer it to the Board of Appeals for consideration.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
