CHAPTER NO. 8 ORDINANCES OF 2010**

An Ordinance Amending Section 2-4-17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth Regarding the Downtown Revitalization Committee

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2-4-17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Plymouth is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 2-4-17 DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION COMMITTEE.

There is hereby established the Downtown Revitalization Committee, which shall have advisory jurisdiction over all economic and development matters involving the downtown business district. Such committee shall consist of the nine (9) citizen members and two (2) Alderperson members. Citizen members shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Common Council for terms of three (3) years at the annual organizational meeting. Initial members shall be appointed, three for a term of one year, three for a term of two years, and three for a term of three years, with terms commencing May 1st of each year. The alderperson members shall be appointed annually at the organizational meeting by the Mayor. The Committee shall organize itself annually and shall appoint such officers as it shall deem appropriate.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
