



## RESOLUTION NO. 25 OF 2018

### A RESOLUTION RELATED TO THE CDBG-CLOSE PROGRAM AND APPROVING THE SELF-CERTIFICATION FOR DEFEDERALIZATION OF THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH CDBG-RLF PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the City of Plymouth received Small Cities Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) in 1985 and 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, the CDBG grants were used to further economic development efforts within the community including the capitalization of a Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) program; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the RLF program is to provide gap financing and assist in economic development expansion within the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Plymouth has not received a CDBG-ED (economic development) award between October 1992 and the present; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Administration Division of Energy, Housing, and Community Resources has proposed a CDBG-CLOSE program that would allow pre-1992 funds to be defederalized upon approval of the CLOSE program by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, that it:

- 1) Certifies that our Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) for Economic Development (ED) was capitalized by grants from the State of Wisconsin before October of 1992;
- 2) Certifies that the City of Plymouth has not received a CDBG-ED award between October 1992 and the present date.
- 3) Authorizes the Office of the Mayor to sign any attestation statement, certification or related document approval for the CDBG-CLOSE program in order to de-federalize the City of Plymouth CDBG-RLF program.

This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its passage by the Common Council.
